Renewal Registration

Key Deposit

You are required to pay a \$50 key deposit upon your initial registration. You will be provided with a key to the track allowing you to practice when it's convenient for you, except for when the track is closed. The key deposit is refundable when track keys are returned to the Treasurer.

Novice Training

Novice Training consists of a minimum of six training sessions and one Novice race. Training begins on Saturday, March 7, 2020. Please bring your race car for the first day and if you don't have a car, you should arrange to have one for day two.
